MISSISSIPPI'S MEDICAID PROGRAM

Medicaid is a program of medical assistance for the needy administered by the states in accordance with provisions of Title XIX of the Social Security Act.

Mississippi began participation in Medicaid on January 1, 1979. The State's Medicaid Program is administered by the Mississippi Medicaid Commission, which was established by House Bill No. 2 of the 1969 Extraordinary Session of the Mississippi Legislature. This law made the benefits of the Medicaid Program available to the following groups of needy persons:

Those who are qualified for public assistance grants under provisions of the following Titles of the Social Security Act as administered by Mississippi's State Department of Public Welfare:

Title I -- Old Age Assistance
Title IV -- Aid to Families with Dependent Children
Title X -- Aid to the Blind
Title XIV -- Aid to the Permanently and Totally Disabled;

Children in foster homes or private institutions for whom Mississippi public agencies are assuming financial responsibility;

Children under twenty-one (21) years of age who, except for age or school attendance requirements, would be dependent children under the Aid to Families with Dependent Children Program (AFDC);

Persons who are patients in a medical facility and who, if they left such facility, would qualify for assistance (money) payments under Old Age Assistance, Aid to the Permanently and Totally Disabled, Aid to the Blind, or Aid to Families with Dependent Children Programs.

There are over 200,000 persons in Mississippi eligible for Medicaid benefits. Benefits available to these persons under Medicaid include the following services:

Inpatient Hospital Services
Outpatient Hospital Services
Skilled Nursing Home Services
Physicians' Services
Laboratory and X-Ray Services
Pharmacy Services
Emergency Ambulance Services
Dental Services
Home Health Services
Eyeglasses Necessitated by Eye Surgery
Christian Science Sanatoria Care and Services
Periodic Screening and Diagnostic Services for Children

Payments for these services are made with 83 percent Federal funds and 17 percent State funds. Participation in Medicaid is entirely voluntary for all providers of authorized medical services.

Hospitals, laboratories, skilled nursing homes, pharmacies, ambulance companies, and home health agencies must meet professional standards and sign a participation agreement in order to receive payment for services provided to Medicaid recipients. A physician or dentist participates in Medicaid when authorized care is provided and institutions participating in the Medicaid Program must be licensed by their respective State licensing agencies.

Director's Foreword

The Mississippi Medicaid Commission is pleased to present this report on Medicaid for Fiscal Year 1971, which was the first full year of activities for the Mississippi Medicaid Program. This report complies with reporting requirements of Section 14 of House Bill No. 2, Extraordinary Session, 1969, (Medical Assistance Act), and in addition provides other information on the Program that may be of interest.

During Fiscal Year 1971, the Medicaid Program was operated within the limits of total funds available from State appropriations and Federal matching monies, ending the year with a small amount of unexpended funds. Over 200,000 persons were eligible for benefits under the Program during the year; approximately 70 percent of these utilized one or more Medicaid services. The Program has undoubtedly improved the accessibility of eligible persons to the health care services available in the State. It has provided a significant amount of Federal funds to cover costs of services provided and thereby undoubtedly contributed to the overall economy of the State and to the development of health care resources, such as facilities and personnel.

There was an expected overall increase of 18,505 eligibles during the year. However, shortly after the end of the year, a Federal court order requiring coverage of caretaker relatives in AFDC households added almost 30,000 new eligibles; this was not expected and the cost of services for these persons was not included in budgetary requests for FY 1972. The additional cost of services for these persons, combined with the anticipated increase in overall costs of the Program for FY 1973, will bring total estimated Program costs for FY 1973 to an amount requiring over eleven million dollars of State appropriations. Section 19 of the Mississippi Medical Assistance Act automatically repeals the Act when the State appropriation exceeds eleven million dollars. This matter will obviously require legislative action if the Program is to be continued past June 30, 1972.

Additionally, the reporting requirement in Section 14 of the Mississippi Medical Assistance Act for all providers receiving over \$5,000 needs upward revision to make the report shorter and more specific in identifying the major providers. (These providers are listed in the Appendices.)

If additional State funding were available for expansion of services, additional dental and eyeglass benefits would be recommended. These services are critically needed for children eligible for Medicaid benefits. Another much needed additional service is coverage of medically related appliances and artificial limbs.

A beneficial revision in the Act would be the addition of clinic services as a covered health service. This would permit the Program to negotiate arrangements with mental health clinics, health departments, and other new systems of health care delivery for payment of several health care services under one global fee rather than payment for each component service on a separate claim. There is real merit in medical assistance programs such as Medicaid encouraging development of new and more efficient health care delivery systems.

The Mississippi Medicaid Program is not fully comprehensive in coverage of services, and it does not reimburse many providers at their usual fees or charges; therefore, it is to be expected that many recipients and providers are often dissatisfied with the Program. Despite this, we believe that the Program has been relatively successful in progressing toward its major objective of improving the accessibility to health care for the eligibles, operating within appropriated funds, contributing to expansions and improvements of health care in the State and coordinating programs and expenditures with other state health agencies and institutions.

Medicaid, 1971

This report reviews the first full year's operation of the Mississippi Medicaid Program. The Medicaid Commission began its first full year of activity on July 1, 1970, after a six-month period of activity when the Program was not fully operational.

On July 1, 1970, five auxiliary services authorized by the original Medicaid legislation were added to the basic services already available. Thus, during Fiscal Year 1971, Medicaid benefits included inpatient and outpatient hospital services, physicians' services, skilled nursing home services, laboratory and X-ray services, drugs, limited dental services, home health services, eyeglasses necessitated by eye surgery, emergency ambulance services, and screening and diagnostic services. Additionally, Medicaid paid the premiums for Medicare Part B (medical services) for most Old Age Assistance recipients covered by Medicare. This service is referred to as the Medicare Buy-in.

During Fiscal Year 1971, the Mississippi Medicaid Program was operated within total funds available from State appropriations and Federal matching monies, ending the year with a small amount of unexpended funds. Over 200,000 persons were eligible for benefits under the Program during the year with approximately 70 percent of these using one or more services.


There were 199,050 persons eligible for Medicaid services at the beginning of Fiscal year 1971, and 217,555 persons eligible at the close of the period. The number of eligibles in the Program categories and the annual rate of increase are shown in Table 1.





No. 2 of the 1969 Extraordinary Session, must come from the State Department of Public Welfare, which, by law, has the responsibility of determining eligibility. This information will be included in the 1971 annual report of the State Department of Public Welfare.




Medical Services

During the first full fiscal year of activity of the Mississippi Medicaid Program a total of \$38,126,339 was expended for services and administration of the Program.

Regulations of Title XIX of the Social Security Act, the Federal Medicaid legislation, provide that Mississippi shall receive Federal funds for 83 percent of the cost of medical services, 75 percent of the cost of professional staffing and related administrative costs, and 50 percent of other administrative costs, as shown in Figure 1. This resulted in 81.9 percent of Medicaid expenditures being Federal funds in FY 1971, as shown in Figure 1. Of the expenditures of \$38,126,339, Federal funds totaled \$31,240,051 or 81.9 percent of expenditures, while 18.1 percent or \$6,886,288 was State money.

Expenditures for administration of the Medicaid Program totaled \$1,279,505, or 3.4 percent of the cost of the Program. This index to Program administration efficiency compares very favorably with other states having similar Medicaid Programs. The actual administrative expense was considerably less than the amount budgeted for this purpose and accounted for most of the unexpended State funds. This is due in large part to a systematized, computerized claims payment and information system, established by a consultant management team on contract with the Mississippi Medicaid Commission and its fiscal agent, Mississippi Hospital and Medical Service (Blue Cross - Blue Shield).

A total of \$41,175,087 was budgeted for the Medicaid Program for FY 1971, and of this amount, \$38,126,339 was expended. Of the unspent balance \$1,198,970 was State funds and this amount reverted to the State Treasury after the close of the fiscal year. The major portion of these unused State funds had been appropriated for administrative expense.

In accordance with the State Plan and State and Federal Regulations for Title XIX, the Mississippi Medicaid Commission requires reimbursement for authorized services where there is third party liability. At the time of a recipient's admission to a hospital and at each of his visits to a doctor's office or other provider of service, a determination is made as to whether the recipient has third party coverage. The Medicaid Program will allow a provider to file a Medicaid claim before a third party payment has been received. However, since the Medicaid liability is always secondary, it is required that any third party payments be used to reduce Medicaid liability and cost and the provider is required to declare and refund any and all collections. A total of \$149,328 was collected in this manner and was used to reduce the cost of medical services from \$36,996,162 to \$36,846,834.

During Fiscal Year 1971, \$36,996,162 was spent for medical services for Medicaid eligibles, with an average of \$177.60 spent per eligible. Medical service expenditures represented 96.6 percent of the total expenditures for Fiscal Year 1971.

The amounts expended for each covered service are shown in Table 2. These expenditures represented over three million claims processed by the fiscal agent for the Program.

Over 65 percent of the funds expended for health services was spent for services provided the 75,000 needy aged persons eligible for the Program. This is due to their much greater relative need for health services, such as drugs and nursing home care. As expected, the disabled used a large percentage of service in comparison to the number of persons in this category. The distribution of money and eligibles by the Program category is Shown in Figure 2.

The \$36,996,162 spent by the Mississippi Medicaid Commission in Fiscal Year 1971 for medical services provided basic health care for Medicaid recipients. Many of the State's most needy citizens received services during the period covered by this report, and, undoubtedly, the Medical Program has improved the accessibility of eligible persons to the health care services available in the State.



During Fiscal Year 1971 there were 15,320 hospital discharges with 113,237 days of inpatient hospital care provided by Medicaid. The average length of stay was 7.4 days. Table 3 shows the average length of stay and related information by Program category.

Additionally, over 38,000 outpatient hospital visits were provided to Medicaid eligibles in Fiscal Year 1971.

A total of 955,946 days of skilled nursing home care was provided by Medicaid in Fiscal Year 1971. The majority of nursing home patients are over 65. Dependent children, blind and disabled used only 8 percent of days of nursing home care covered by Medicaid.

The Mississippi Medicaid Commission paid for 537,364 visits to physicians in Fiscal Year 1971. The average number of visits per eligible person was 4.1, with persons in the Aid to Permanently and Totally Disabled making the greatest number of visits as illustrated in Table 4.

A total of 2,161,340 prescriptions was paid for by the Mississippi Medicaid Program in Fiscal Year 1971, with an average of 10.4 prescriptions per eligible person, as illustrated in Table 5.

State agencies and institutions received \$1,176,725 in payments for services provided Medicaid eligibles during the year. Near the end of the year two State institutions, East Mississippi State Hospital at Meridian and Ellisville State School at Ellisville, began participation in the skilled nursing home program. This will increase the total payments to State institutions during Fiscal Year 1972 by a significant amount. The Medicaid staff has worked closely with all State health agencies toward reaching the objectives of fiscal coordination intended under the Medical Assistance Act. The amounts paid to individual institutions are shown in Table 6.

An active field investigation program has been maintained by the Mississippi Medicaid Commission for detection of Program abuse or fraud. The primary basis for our investigation program is a profile exception reporting system based on computer programs to periodically furnish information on providers and recipients who exceed pre-determined norms. Other indications of potential problem areas are found in claim records and in complaints and reports of alleged fraudulent practices by recipients and/or providers. All such indications and reports are carefully and promptly investigated.

Eighty-five physicians' records were reviewed in Fiscal Year 1971 to substantiate delivery of services for which payments were made. From these audits, seven physicians were requested to make refunds amounting to \$1,954.60. All requested refunds have been made. Additional investigations are continuing on several cases.

Several dentists' records have been reviewed, and in one situation sixteen patients were examined to verify receipt of services as claimed. One dentist was required to refund \$3,195 and disqualified from participation in the Program for an indefinite period; also, evidence in this case has been turned over to State and Federal authorities for possible further legal action.
