# Medicaid Family Planning Waiver Program

Medicaid Family Planning Waiver services are services provided to eligible beneficiaries who voluntarily choose to prevent pregnancy, plan the number of pregnancies, or plan the spacing between pregnancies.

The purpose of the Family Planning Waiver Program is to decrease unwanted pregnancies, increase the spacing between pregnancies and increase the number of referrals for primary care to improve the health of child bearing women in the state of Mississippi.

## What you should know about the Family Planning Waiver Program!

Family Planning Waiver services are provided, with limitations, in the following general categories:

- Office Visits
- Voluntary Sterilization
- Laboratory Procedures
- Contraceptive Devices
- Contraceptive Prescriptions for:
  - ➡ Contraceptive patches
  - ➡ Self-inserted contraceptive products (like NuvaRing)
  - ➡ Oral contraceptive agents (pills)
  - ➡ Injectable contraceptive (like Depo-Provera)

### Who Can Get These Services?

- Women ages 13-44 who live in Mississippi
- Women who meet income requirements
- Women who are U.S. citizens or legally in the country
- Women who have not had surgery to prevent pregnancy

### Where Can You Get These Services?

- Participating Mississippi Medicaid Providers
- Community Health Centers
- County Health Departments

### What's Not Covered?

Beneficiaries enrolled in the Family Planning Waiver Program have Medicaid coverage for family planning services **only**.

- These women are not eligible for other Medicaid pharmacy services.
- These women are not eligible to receive any other regular Medicaid benefits.

### Prescription Information

Beneficiaries enrolled in the Family Planning Waiver Program may have a prescription for contraceptives written by any Medicaid participating provider filled at their local Medicaid participating pharmacy.

Prescription contraceptives are also available through private providers enrolled in the Mississippi State Department of Health's family planning program.

### Primary Care Referrals

When you see a doctor for family planning, if he or she finds that you have another health problem that needs to be treated, he or she will give you a primary care referral. This means he or she will tell you where you can go to see another doctor about your health problem.
