This letter is not about your Medicaid Benefits. This letter is only about how we'll keep your health facts.

We value the privacy of your **Protected Health Information (PHI)**. **PHI** is information that identifies you, like your name and date of birth. **PHI** is also information about your health kept in your health care records. We call **PHI** your **health facts**.

In April, 2010, Medicaid will make your health facts available to your doctor or healthcare provider through a computer in order to better treat you. The doctor will be able to see the kinds of medicine you take, any health problems you have, and your allergies. The doctor will **NOT** be able to see health facts about alcohol and drug abuse.

You probably go to more than one doctor for your health care. Sometimes it's important for your doctors to know about all of the care you're getting. Making your health facts available through a computer lets your doctors see your health facts. Having these health facts helps you and your doctors make better choices about your care. Doctors can also write your medicines from their own computers and send them right to your pharmacy.

Doctors can see your health facts BUT the public can't see them.
