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Medicaid Awarded Payment Accuracy Measurement Grant

The Office of the Governor, Division of Medicaid will use a \$891,363 grant to study and develop additional methodologies for measurement of the accuracy of payments for Medicaid services, and to create effective models for use by other states and the nation. Medicaid is committed to accuracy in claims processing.

The Department of Health & Human Services, Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) awarded the grant to fund a demonstration project to build on the experiences of various states in the development of a Payment Accuracy Measurement System (PAM) for Medicaid.
