

MINUTES
STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES
MARCH 15, 1995

The March 15, 1995, dinner meeting of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges was held at Tico's Steak House on County Line Road in Jackson, Mississippi. The meeting began at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday evening, with Board members Paul Breazeale, Patricia Puckett, William Seal, Hazel Terry, and George Walker present. Staff in attendance included: Dr. Olon Ray, Executive Director, R. L. McClellan and Ed Schneider. Also in attendance was Mrs. Paul Breazeale. Members absent were: Alton Bankston, Amos Bridges, Perrin Purvis, Dr. Barbara Ricks, and Nell Rogers.

Dr. Ray announced the appointment of two new Board members, Mr. John R. Junkin, II, who will replace Amos Bridges, and Ms. Yvonne Brown who will replace Dr. Barbara Ricks. Terms of service for the new Board members will begin July 1, 1995.

Because of the inclusive approval used by community colleges as reflected in its mission policies, Chairman Breazeale suggested that it would be advisable for SBCJC members to become more familiar with those policies.

George Walker gave a brief report on work force education.

Dr. Ray announced the success of the Coahoma Community College District bill, in that it had passed the Mississippi House of Representatives.

Ed Schneider reported on the mobile classroom/labs selection process and purchase.
