HOUSE BILL NO. 1574


AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JERRY EUGENE
ARNOLD OF TIPPDAH COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and completely restored to Jerry Eugene Arnold of Tippah County, Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his conviction of Grand Larceny in Tippah County, Mississippi, in 1990, and who has completed the penalty and any conditions imposed upon him for such conviction. The Legislature has been reliably informed that he is now conducting himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.


