SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 596

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND CONGRATULATING THE HOME BUILDERS ASSOCIATION OF MISSISSIPPI ON THE OCCASION OF ITS 50th ANNIVERSARY.
