SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 685

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE DEDICATED PROFESSIONAL SERVICE OF TIPPAH COUNTY CORONER DAVID HUBBARD ON THE OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT FROM OFFICE.

fairness. He has set the highest standard in all of his many roles, as father, husband, health care professional, citizen and leader in Tippah County, and it is with great pride that we salute this outstanding Mississippi public servant:
