TO THE MISSISSIPPI HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

GOVERNOR'S VETO MESSAGE FOR HOUSE BILL 868

I am returning House Bill Number 868: "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO APPLY 1 FOR FEDERAL GRANTS AND TO PROVIDE AN INFLUENZA VACCINATION SCHOOL 2 PROGRAM IN MISSISSIPPI FOR SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN 5 THROUGH 18 YEARS 3 OF AGE AND TO PROVIDE CERTAIN STANDARDS FOR THE PROGRAM; AND FOR 4 RELATED PURPOSES." without my approval, and assign the following reasons for my veto.

House Bill 868 covers the same topic as Senate Bill 2220 which I have signed into law today. House Bill 868 also contains a reverse repealer which would repeal the act June 30, 2011 prior to taking effect on July 1, 2011. Therefore, there is no need for House Bill 868.
