SENATE BILL NO. 2002

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 928, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2004, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 934, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2007, TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF TUNICA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO THE TUNICA COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION, INC., THROUGH AND INCLUDING CALENDAR YEAR 2017; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. Chapter 928, Local and Private Laws of 2004, as amended by Chapter 934, Local and Private Laws of 2007, is amended as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of Tunica County, Mississippi, is authorized and empowered, in its discretion, from any available funds of the county, to provide funding for the Tunica County Economic Development Foundation, Inc., (the "foundation"), in an amount not to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) annually through calendar year 2017.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
