SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 609

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE HORN LAKE HIGH SCHOOL "LADY EAGLES" GIRLS BASKETBALL TEAM AND COACH JANNA THOMPSON FOR A DOMINATING CLASS 6A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

WHEREAS, Horn Lake High School "Lady Eagles" Girls Basketball Team won the Class 6A MHSAA Girls Basketball Championship by routing Olive Branch 74-39 on March 15, 2014, at the Mississippi Coliseum; and

WHEREAS, A'Queen Hayes fouled out in the fourth quarter. She was cheered on as she made her way down the bench, and then she pointed to the crowd. Hayes finished with nine points, but she was perfect from the field.
