

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 610

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE EAST WEBSTER HIGH SCHOOL "WOLVERINES" CHEERLEADING SQUAD AND COACH SHAWNA WILLIAMS FOR WINNING THEIR SECOND CONSECUTIVE MHSAA CLASS 1A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

WHEREAS, the East Webster High School "Wolverines" Cheerleaders competed in the MHSAA State Cheerleading and Dance Competition on December 14, 2013, and won State Championships in both Cheer (Small Non-Tumbling) and Dance (Small Pom).
