WHEREAS, always a friendly and enthusiastic librarian, Mrs. McCune especially cared for the children's programs of the library, and she tried throughout the years to focus on building the children's resources in the library, successfully expanding the summer reading program from 17 participants in its year of inception to 120 participants in 2012; and

WHEREAS, under Mrs. McCune's leadership as the driving force behind its operations, the Iuka Library increased from a circulation of 28,254 in 1979 to a circulation of 65,118 in 2012, increased its books from 10,399 to 33,413 during the same span of


time, and underwent a major renovation and addition in 1995 and the computerization of the entire card catalog system; and


