- By their own admission and best case scenario, there is still an \$82M deficit – which equates to a total of \$328M in health care services lost for the people of Mississippi.
- If you cut all optional services with the exception of nursing homes and prescription drugs, you could reach a total savings of \$49.5M.
- Under any scenario, in order to achieve the \$328-480M savings necessary, you must cut nursing homes and prescription drugs.
