I have been speaking this week with Ramona Oliver, director of communications with the DGA. She would like to meet with Lee Ann and me as soon as we can to share some information about the Musgrove administration in preparation for next year.

The governor is scheduled to be in DC on December 4-5 for JAG meetings. Lee Ann and I discussed the possibility of traveling with him at that time to meet with Ramona. Phillip, Richard and Armerita are also wanting to go on that flight, and there are space restrictions to consider. Ramona has said DGA could bring Lee Ann and me to DC, or she would be willing to come to Jackson.

On December 9, Ramona would like to have the governor in DC for the day and into the night. That morning he could be one of three, no more than four, governors speaking at the Sperling Breakfast, a weekly breakfast of 30-40 of the top print journalists in DC, hosted by the Christian Science Monitor.

After the breakfast, Ramona has talked about taking the governor around to meet with senior network political producers and reporters (see attached page). A private event would be held in the evening.

Regardless of whether or not the governor can be in DC on the 9th, Ramona will be holding a training session for communications directors.
