A Proclamation by Governor Ronnie Musgrove

TO THE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE:

By virtue of the provisions of Section 121 of the Constitution of the State of Mississippi, and in conformity with the Proclamation issued August 30, 2002, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, do herewith submit in writing the following additional matters for the consideration of the Legislature in the Third Extraordinary Session convening on Thursday, September 5, 2002, at 10:00 a.m., to wit:

1. An act to reenact section 73-21-108, Mississippi Code of 1972, as it existed on June 30, 2001, and additionally to ratify the issuance of permits by the State Board of Pharmacy and reimbursement payments by the Division of Medicaid for durable medical equipment from July 1, 2001 until the effective date of this act.
