I received a call from Doug Walker with WLOX. They will be up here Friday with a satellite truck, and would like to do what is called a "look live" interview with you for their show, "News Watch This Week." They would have the satellite doing a feed to a studio on the Coast, and you would be interviewed by the hosts in the studio for a show that will air Saturday evening at 6:00p.m. I am trying to get more information regarding the questions they want to ask.

This show is 30 minutes long, with three segments; they would like to have you on for 2 segments (each one lasting 8-9 minutes).

There is a problem in that the interview must be done either outside or in a first floor setting; they only have about 200 feet of cable for their truck. Except for the Mansion, there's really no place to do an indoor interview, and I'm not crazy about the idea of a 30-minute outside interview.

The only time they can do it Friday is at 2:00p.m. They would need you in place at 1:50p.m., and the interview would be over at approximately 2:20p.m. You have a staff meeting scheduled in Woolfolk at that time.

It would be good to get more television exposure on the Coast, but I'm not comfortable with the set-up. I think it would work better with you in the studio.
