I checked with Boyd after I got back to the office. He said that the Governor is doing the event because Robert Latham wants him to do it. I shared the Governor's comments with Boyd. Boyd said that there will be a huge crowd (around 400) at the banquet. I told Boyd that I'd include his comments in this memo to you.
