These public hearings will provide interested parties an opportunity to comment on the proposed redesignation of the Client Assistance Program (CAP) grant, a federal grant that provides advocacy services to Mississippians seeking or receiving services from the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation under Section 112 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 as revised in 1998. These hearings will be held Thursday, July 27, and Wednesday, August 2, at 1:30 p.m. in the Easter Seals Mississippi offices at 3226 North State Street, Jackson.
