HB 580

HB 580 designates that portion of Mississippi Highway 4 in Prentiss County beginning at the western boundary of Booneville and extending westerly to the Prentiss/Tippah county line (approximately 6 miles) as the "Hershel G. Jumper Memorial Highway." HB 580 also requires MDOT to erect and maintain signs approaching this section of highway with this designation.

Jumper was a World War II veteran, former Prentiss County Chancery Clerk (1952-1960) and Former Northern District Highway Commissioner (1968-1976).

HB 580 is effective July 1, 2002.

I recommend that you sign HB 580.
