HB 686

HB 686 amends current law to allow the spouse or child of a member of the armed forces who is out of state on military duty to renew his or her driver's license without being penalized with a delinquent fee or examination if the spouse or child resides out of state with the armed services member and his or her license expired while they were out of state. Current law only allows the member of the armed forces to renew his or her driver's license without a penalty.

HB 686 is effective July 1, 2002.

Larry Waggoner and Lane Jenkins of DPS spoke on behalf of this bill in Rep. Rotenberry's transportation sub-committee.

I have not heard of or received any opposition to this bill.

I recommend that you sign HB 686.
