HB 1419

HB 1419 designates the following highway segments and requires MDOT to erect and maintain proper signage for each:

- The Mississippi Highway 304 spur in Tunica County is to be designated the “Martin Luther King, Jr., Memorial Highway”
- The bridge on Cowan-Lorraine Road in Harrison County that spans the Harrison County Industrial Seaway is to be designated the “Eugene P. Wilkes Memorial Bridge” (NOTE: This designation was added by the Senate, but Margaret Chambliss has not been in her office for me to get a copy of the resolution to determine who Mr. Wilkes was. I checked with Security and he was not a highway patrolman. No one answered at the Harrison County Board of Supervisors’ office.)
- That portion of Smithdale Road (Mississippi 570) between Northwest Avenue and Enterprise Road in McComb is to be designated as “Veterans Boulevard”
- That segment of Mississippi 603 in Hancock County beginning at I-10 and extending northerly to Kiln is to be designated “Stennis Airport Parkway.”

HB 1419 is effective from and after passage.

I recommend that you sign HB 1419.
