SB 2423 and HB 1486 cap the School Ad Valorem Tax Reduction Fund and appropriate the excess to the Education Enhancement Fund. During previous discussions with Senator Chaney (author of the bills), the excess (approximately \$8 million) would be set aside for the purchase of computers for the Governor's Task Force for Classroom Technology (E.O. 831). However, I have not seen language in the bill specifying that the money should be set-aside for any particular purpose.

*Please review the legislation and offer an amendment that would require the monies to be used for the purchase of computers and connectivity.*
