WHEREAS, Bryan Keith Lindsey is the son of Fred and LaVerne Young Lindsey, and the twin brother of Byron Kevin Lindsey—born in Lexington, Mississippi, Bryan Lindsey graduated from the Lexington Attendance Center High School in 1975, received a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1978 and a Masters of Public Policy and Administration in 1982 from Jackson State University, and earned his PhD from the University of Tennessee-Knoxville; and

WHEREAS, he was a Post Doctoral Fellow in HIV/AIDS prevention with the Center for Disease Control and Prevention from 1987 to 1989; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Bryan Keith Lindsey is currently on loan from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene where he serves in a capacity-building assignment as the Assistant Commissioner for Minority, Immigrant, and Refugee Health; and

WHEREAS, prior to his selection as Assistant Commissioner, Dr. Lindsey served as the Associate Director of the Tuskegee University National Center for Bioethics in Research and Health Care at Tuskegee Institute, Alabama, and also served as Project Officer and Health Education Specialist with the Center for Disease Control and Prevention's National Center for Chronic Disease Prevention and Health Promotion and The National Center for HIV/STD/TB Prevention; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Lindsey is an active member of historic Ebenezer Baptist Church in Atlanta, Georgia, and is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Bryan Keith Lindsey has received several national awards and has served on a number of boards and associations; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson State University Alumni Association-Metro New York Chapter will recognize Dr. Bryan Keith Lindsey at the June 15, 2003, STAR Program which honors native Mississippians in the tri-state New York area for outstanding achievements in their endeavors:
