A large portion of this meeting will be spent discussing the impact of *No Child Left Behind* on NAGB's work. This is the first board meeting since *No Child Left Behind* passed. Secretary of Education Paige is expected to attend the meeting from noon until about 3:00 Friday afternoon to discuss *No Child Left Behind* and to swear in Governor Kempthorne. Mark Musick and Roy Truby will also brief the Board on the implications of *No Child Left Behind* for NAEP late Friday afternoon.

The agenda for Friday morning follows the typical format: Gary Phillips of NCES will give the Board an update on NAEP and you'll then break into your committees. Your Committee on Standards, Design and Methodology is scheduled to discuss three items, two of which are technical implications of *No Child Left Behind*. The third is an informational briefing on the findings of combining the state and national samples from the 1998 Grade 4 Reading data and the 2000 Grade 8 Math data.

Michael Nettles will provide the Board with the final report of the Ad Hoc Committee on Confirming Test Results during Friday afternoon's discussions. This is the blue report in the front pocket of your meeting book.

Bill Cody and his wife, Caroline, are hosting the Board at their home Friday evening for dinner.

The meeting is scheduled to conclude at noon on Saturday.
