Dr. Anne Hancock, regional representative for the USDE, will be in town on November 19 and has requested a 10-15 minute courtesy visit with the Governor, to be followed by a more lengthy meeting with me. I am requesting that the Governor meet with Dr. Hancock at 9:30 a.m. that morning (between his visit with Morris Strickland and his speaking to the government class at Brandon High School).

The Governor met Dr. Hancock during the Following the Leaders flag raising event in Water Valley last Monday. Bill and I then saw her at the ARC meeting in Knoxville where she mentioned the Water Valley event during her speech. She later asked me about the Computers in the Classroom Initiative to make sure she understood correctly that we would have an Internet-accessible computer in every classroom by the end of this year. She also informed me that she had mentioned to the Governor at Water Valley that she was going to be in town and would like to meet with him and he referred her to me because it related to education.
