Per the Governor's directions at this morning's staff meeting, I have made arrangements for town hall meetings in Biloxi and Tupelo next Monday and Tuesday. Here are the details:

Monday, February 18, 2002, 5:00 p.m.  
Biloxi High School Auditorium, 1424 Father Ryan Avenue, Biloxi

Superintendent: Dr. Larry Drawdy (Melissa, asst), 228-374-1810  
Facilities/Set Up: Nolan Broussard, 228-374-1810

We have the auditorium reserved from 4:00-7:00 p.m. The auditorium holds 1,100. I set the event up through Dr. Drawdy and Broussard.

I have requested a cordless microphone or a lavalier for the Governor to use.

Dr. Drawdy is going to get the word out to his people. I have left voicemail for Tom Clark of the Gulf Coast Education Consortium requesting his assistance in getting the word out to his superintendents and communities.

We need to send out a media advisory. Dr. Drawdy said that we need to make sure that Mary Kay (Kate) Dickerson of the Sun Herald knows about it because she has recently written several articles about education funding.

As far as travel, I guess this is a state plane trip. He is in Vicksburg from 2:30-3:00. Does he fly straight from Vicksburg to Coast? Phillip and I would like to staff the Governor at this event as we are working on the grass roots education campaign. Peyton is scheduled to staff him at the 7:30-8:00 p.m. Jewish congregation event.
