This four-week summer program honors excellence in science and encourages thoughtful scientific leadership through scientific lectures, hands-on research opportunities, and a challenging outdoor recreational program. The program seeks to broaden, inspire and promote the interest of our youth in pursuing scientific careers and to encourage thoughtful scientific leadership for our nation's future.

The National Youth Science Foundation covers all expenses of the students' participation, including travel. Candidates must be available to participate in the entire program, June 28 to July 23, 2001.
