Representative Lott has an 8:30 appointment with you this morning to discuss HB 52.

HB 52 authorizes (“may” not “shall”) local school districts to establish a vocational study program through which students may earn high school units for vocational experience as an alternative to those units required by the district in addition to the state core curriculum. Students in the vocational program must complete the core curriculum and may be earn 8 high school units through the vocational program. The State Board of Education must recognize the units in fulfillment of the local district’s graduation requirements.

The sub-committee passed HB 52 on January 22 and the full Education Committee may consider it today.
