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According to Thomas, S. 2 is still under consideration in the Senate, having last been considered on May 9. Thirty-nine amendments have been offered for S. 2, with the following four agreed to:

- S. AMDT.3104 to S.2 (Sen. Collins) to modify the list of eligible programs that may be subject to a performance partnership agreement, was agreed to on May 8.
- S. AMDT.3110 to S.2 (Sen. Gorton) to strengthen the Academic Achievement for All Demonstration Act (the Straight A's Act), was agreed to on May 3.
- S. AMDT.3117 to S.2 (Sen. Abraham) to reform certain State requirements relating to the use of funds to improve student academic achievement and student performance and to coordinate professional development activities, was agreed to on May 4.
- S. AMDT.3126 to S.2 (Sen. Lott) to improve the provisions relating to teachers, was agreed to on May 8.

*House Action*

- H.R. 3222, which would amend the Even Start program, was placed on the Union Calendar on February 29.
- The House considered H.R. 3616, which would reauthorize Impact Aid programs, under suspension of rules on May 15. The House agreed to suspend the rules and pass the bill on voice vote. A motion to reconsider was laid on the table and agreed to without objection. H.R. 3616 was received in the Senate on May 16 and is on the Senate Legislation Calendar under General Orders.
- H.R. 4141, which would reauthorize several programs including Technology for Education and Safe and Drug-Free Schools and would permit states and school districts to transfer funds among various grant programs, was placed on the Union Calendar on May 4.
