- Want to visit with you about Mississippi, where we're headed and the roles you can play in getting us there

- Lots of challenges before us
 - Turning challenges into opportunities

- This work demands leadership
 - Must be proactive, not reactive
 - Must come from all levels, from student council to governor's office

- One of two governors in nation working on "No Child Left Behind"
 - Also worked to reauthorize special education legislation / IDEA

- Great progress being made in education
 - Teacher pay
 - Computers in Classroom
 - NGA: MS at head of wave of technological innovations
 - First state in nation to do this

- MS students taking leadership role in this effort
 - Building nearly 1,000 computers from scratch

- MS one of six states in “Following the Leaders” project
 - Reflection of role with “No Child Left Behind”

- Work in education is broad, but has focused goal
 - Quality education means quality jobs

- That’s another area where leadership is making a difference
 - Mississippi being recognized as a leader

- Focusing on creating quality, high-paying jobs for people
 - Want / need you to stay in MS
 - Continue the work we're doing now

- By turning challenges into opportunities, we're growing MS
 - This state is open for business
 - 47,000 new jobs / 21,000 from existing businesses
 - \$12.9 billion invested

- MS one of top ten states in nation for small business survival
 - 54,000 small businesses in MS

- We've got goals for the future / on target with those goals
 - Need to maintain the momentum
 - Need for you to take on leadership role in schools / communities

- Many more challenges ahead of us
 - Help us turn them into opportunities

- Simple definition of a leader: someone who knows where he or she wants to go, gets up and goes
 - Confident you know where you want to go

 - Excited about work you'll do in years to come
 - Excited about difference you'll help make for MS
