A Proclamation By Governor Ronnie Musgrove

WHEREAS, daily consumption of a folic acid B-vitamin, when taken before a pregnancy begins, has been proven to reduce the risk of certain neural and spinal birth defects by up to 70%; and

WHEREAS, according to recent research only 25% of women in Mississippi consume a folic acid multivitamin daily before pregnancy, and only 19% are aware that consumption must occur before conception; and

WHEREAS, Mississippi has the largest percentage of infants born with low birthweight, and the highest percentage rate of infant mortality in the country; and

WHEREAS, a number of organizations are working to educate the women of Mississippi on how to prevent birth defects and decrease infant mortality:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, hereby proclaim the week of September 8 through September 14, 2002, as

FOLIC ACID AWARENESS MONTH

in the State of Mississippi and I urge all citizens to pass along this vital message, to consume folic acid and ensure a future in which every child will be born healthy and to continue to work together to save babies.
