## **MDOC NAMES SMCI CHAPLAIN AS 2002 EMPLOYEE OF THE YEAR**

Jackson— The Mississippi Department of Corrections (MDOC) on Wednesday presented the agency's second annual Employee of the Year award to Sister Kathleen Spurlin, a 24-year veteran with MDOC. Spurlin supervises the Chaplain's Department at the South Mississippi Correctional Institution in Leakesville. Sister Spurlin received the award at a banquet honoring more than a hundred MDOC employees.

Governor Ronnie Musgrove was the featured speaker at the event, which included a handful of state elected officials from the Senate Corrections and House Penitentiary committees, corrections employees, the Mississippi Prison Industries Corporation CEO and board member representatives, Parole Board members and family and friends of the five nominees of the Employee of the Year award. MDOC initiated the employee recognition awards program in 2001 and hosted the first Employee of the Year luncheon last year to honor employees who received employee awards during the year.

"We've got some of the best, hardest working people of the state of Mississippi working at the Department of Corrections," said Governor Musgrove. "You all have a tremendous responsibility in your challenging role of maintaining security, custody control, treatment and care in a most difficult environment. Thank you for the job you do, and thank you for your commitment as public servants."

In calendar year 2002 there were 116 MDOC employees who were recognized for their daily dedication and hard work in maintaining public safety through offender care, custody, control and treatment. An employee from each of the three state institutions (Central Mississippi Correctional Facility, Mississippi State Penitentiary and South Mississippi Correctional Institution), the Community Corrections Division and Central Office were selected as the Employee of the Year nominees.

The five nominees for Employee of the Year included:

- Sister Kathleen Spurlin, MDOC Employee of the Year. Spurlin, Chaplain II at the South Mississippi Correctional Institution in Leakesville, has been an employee of MDOC for 24 years. Spurlin received the Staff Employee of the Month Award for April 2002.
