State Inmate Escapes from Pike Satellite Facility

Jackson - A state inmate escaped early this morning from the Pike County Satellite Facility in Magnolia, Miss. Authorities are searching for offender Phillip Kincaid, a 39-year old black male with brown eyes, black hair and weighs 165 pounds.

According to MDOC officials, Kincaid was discovered missing around 4 a.m. today during a security bed check at the satellite facility. Kincaid was last seen at 3 a.m. Authorities believe that Kincaid climbed over the minimum-security fence line behind the housing unit and escaped into the cover of darkness. Law enforcement authorities were notified immediately of the escape and a warrant was issued for the inmate's arrest. Kincaid was serving 30 years on several charges including general burglary, residential burglary and arson from Scott County, Mississippi. Authorities state that Kincaid was scheduled to be discharged from the supervision of the Mississippi Department of Corrections on April 25, 2003.

Kincaid is believed to be wearing green and white striped pants and a white shirt with **MDOC Convict** printed on the back. He is not considered to be dangerous. Anyone with any information or sightings of Kincaid should contact local law enforcement.
