Governor Ronnie Musgrove to Host Round Table Discussion on Mississippi Delta Region

Governor Ronnie Musgrove will host a round table discussion on the Mississippi Delta Region today at the Viking Range Corporation in Greenwood, Mississippi beginning at 4:30 p.m. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss issues important to the Mississippi Delta Region and how we can work together to assist in addressing these issues.

“Through this round table, we are developing a Delta-wide effort to make improvements in infrastructure, education, healthcare, economic development, agriculture, environmental issues and rural development,” said Governor Musgrove. “To be effective, this effort will require the support of businesses, educators, colleges, universities, foundations, local, state and federal government and interested individuals.”

The findings from today’s round table discussion will be presented at the National Conference on the Delta that will be held this May in Washington, D.C. “By partnering with other states, and by working with local leaders, we can create community-based development and tackle the toughest challenges facing Delta counties today,” said the Governor.
