## **Governor Makes Appointments to the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws**

Jackson, Miss. – Governor Ronnie Musgrove has made three appointments to the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws (NCCUSL). John M. Harrell of Gulfport, Regina R. Quinn of Jackson, Samuel Davis of University have been appointed to serve as Commissioners of the organization.

The NCCUSL is the national conference that develops model and uniform act for every enactment in the various states. The conference was organized in 1892 to promote uniformity in state law by voluntary action of each state government. Mississippi has been a member state of the conference since its beginning, and we have adopted more than 40 uniform acts promulgated by the conference.

The Conference meets annually to consider drafts of proposed uniform legislation. “Each of the Commissioners have backgrounds in law and will use their knowledge and experiences to represent Mississippi well,” said Governor Musgrove.
