Governor Names Chief of Staff

Jackson, Miss. – Governor Ronnie Musgrove today named William J. Renick (Bill) as Chief of Staff for the Office of the Governor. Bill was born in Ashland, Mississippi and graduated from Frayser High School in Memphis, Tennessee.
