**GOVERNOR MUSGROVE AWARDS EMERGENCY PUBLIC FACILITIES GRANT
TO TOWN OF CENTREVILLE**

JACKSON, Miss. – Governor Ronnie Musgrove recently announced the latest Emergency Public Facilities Grant awarded to the Town of Centreville.

“The state of Mississippi understands that community building is at the heart of economic development. We are pleased to partner with local officials as they strive to improve their communities,” commented Governor Musgrove.

The Town of Centreville receives Emergency Public Facility funds through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program in the amount of \$25,180 for public facilities improvements.
