**GOVERNOR MUSGROVE AWARDS EMERGENCY PUBLIC FACILITIES GRANT
TO TOWN OF GOODMAN**

JACKSON, Miss. – Governor Ronnie Musgrove recently announced the latest Emergency Public Facilities Grant awarded to the Town of Goodman.

“Communities need the right tools for economic development and growth. With tools like the Emergency Public Facilities grant program, the state of Mississippi prepares communities to embrace the opportunities available for prosperity and a higher quality of life for our people,” commented Governor Musgrove.

The Town of Goodman receives Emergency Public Facility funds through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program in the amount of \$62,500 for public facilities improvements.

CDBG is a program of the Community Services Division of the Mississippi Development Authority. Among the division’s goals are assisting communities in analyzing their strengths and weaknesses, involving their leadership in economic development, planning development strategies, strengthening development organizations, and implementing and financing community projects. The Community Services Division also administers other Economic Development grant and loan programs.
