WHEREAS, the Itawamba Community College 2003 Indians baseball team, under the leadership of head coach Rick Collier and assisted by Justin Entrekin and Chad Case, finished the season with a 46-11 record and a fifth place finish in the world series; and

WHEREAS, the Indians won many championships including the MACJC North Division Championship, the MACJC State Championship, the NJCAA Division II Region 23 Championship and the NJCAA Division II Central District Championship; and

WHEREAS, since 1983, 15 Indian players have been drafted and in 2003 Tim Dillard was drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers:
