Nissan Continues To Accept Applications For Production Workers

Automaker Nissan will continue to accept applications for production workers to be employed at its \$930 assembly plant currently under construction in Madison County until the end of the year.

The Mississippi Employment Security Commission (MESC) is handling recruitment for Nissan production workers and maintenance technicians. The MESC unit receives the applications and screens them to ensure applicants meet Nissan's qualifications. MESC then sends the screened applications to Nissan, which does the interviewing and hiring.

Applications may be obtained at any MESC office statewide. Interested parties may also receive an application by sending a self-addressed, stamped business envelope (4 1/2 x 9 1/2 inches) with your name, address and telephone number to the Mississippi Employment Security Commission, Box 1247, Canton, MS 39046.
