**GOVERNOR MUSGROVE AWARDS EMERGENCY PUBLIC FACILITIES FUNDS TO TOWN OF NEW AUGUSTA**

JACKSON, Miss – Governor Ronnie Musgrove recently announced the latest Community Development Block Grant awarded to the town of New Augusta.

The town of New Augusta receives Emergency Public Facility funds through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program in the amount of \$71,140 for public facilities improvements.

“The state of Mississippi is interested in improving the quality of life for each of its citizens,” Governor Musgrove stated. “The CDBG program helps communities build toward future growth and prosperity.”

CDBG is a program of the Community Services Division of the Mississippi Development Authority, which administers technical and financial assistance programs that help communities prepare for growth. Through its Emergency Public Facilities funds, the CDBG program assists communities in making improvements to basic services, such as water, wastewater, solid waste, selected public buildings, drainage, etc.
