GOVERNOR MUSGROVE AWARDS EMERGENCY PUBLIC FACILITIES FUNDS TO TOWN OF OSYKA

JACKSON, Miss. – Governor Ronnie Musgrove recently announced the latest Community Development Block Grant awarded to the town of Osyka.

The town of Osyka receives Emergency Public Facility funds through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program in the amount of \$19,722 for public facilities improvements.

“A strong state economy starts in the local communities,” Governor Musgrove observed. “The state of Mississippi supports the town of Osyka as it builds toward future growth and prosperity.”

CDBG is a program of the Community Services Division of the Mississippi Development Authority, which administers technical and financial assistance programs that help communities prepare for growth.
