**TUNICA COUNTY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AWARDED ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT MARKETING MATCH GRANT**

JACKSON, MS – Governor Ronnie Musgrove recently announced the latest round of Economic Development Marketing Match Grants. The Tunica County Chamber of Commerce was one of the awardees.

“The state of Mississippi recognizes the efforts of our communities to create a pro-business environment that promotes economic development,” said Governor Musgrove. “This grant demonstrates our commitment to help communities attract jobs and a better way of life for our citizens.”

The Tunica County Chamber of Commerce receives \$8,000.00, to develop and produce marketing materials.

The Economic Development Marketing Match Grants Program, administered by the Community Services division of the Mississippi Development Authority (MDA), assists nonprofit economic development entities in marketing regions of the state and communities as a site for business and industrial development. The goal is to enhance the marketing of the State of Mississippi by enabling regions and communities to market themselves.

To be considered for funding, projects must have a definable impact on business and industrial attraction or retention. Projects should take a regional approach rather than focusing on a single community. Eligible applicants include nonprofit economic development entities that serve at a minimum countywide.
