GOVERNOR MUSGROVE AWARDS TOWN OF WESSON LOAN FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

JACKSON, Miss. – Governor Ronnie Musgrove recently announced the latest Capital Improvements Revolving Loan (CAP) awarded to the town of Wesson.

Wesson receives a CAP loan in the amount of \$80,000, and will be used for improvements within the town.

“The state of Mississippi supports Wesson in its commitment to improving the quality of life for its residents,” commented Governor Musgrove. “By investing in our communities, we strengthen our entire state.”

The Capital Improvements Revolving Loan program, under the direction of the community Services Division of the Mississippi Development Authority, is designed for making loans to Mississippi’s counties or municipalities to finance improvements with the purpose of attracting new businesses or enhancing existing business. Funding for loans to applicants is derived from the issuance of state bonds.
