(Jackson, MS) – Governor Ronnie Musgrove will hold a series of ceremonial bill signings on Wednesday, April 17. The bills to be signed are listed. Bill signings between 9am and 11:15am will take place in the Governor’s Capitol office; signings after 1:30pm will be in Room 216 of the State Capitol.

- 9:00 a.m. HB 576 – Highway system; designate segment of U.S. 49 in Simpson county as "Sheriff E.C. Mullins Memorial Highway"
- 9:15 a.m. SB 2481 – Crime stoppers; authorize surcharge to fund, expand authority to form, revise confidentiality
- 9:30 a.m. HB 605 – County court; authorize additional county court judge in Rankin county, authorize additional county court judge in Madison county
- 9:45 a.m. SB 2797 – Water and sewer services; authorize submetering to certain residents.
- 10:00 a.m. HB 1562 – Construction contracts; revise retainage provisions and require reporting of payment to subcontractors.
- 10:15 a.m. HB 1130 – Ethanol; authorize Commissioner of Agriculture to make cash payments to producers of.
- 10:30 a.m. HB 465 – Driver education and training program; require to include instruction in organ donation.
- 10:45 a.m. SB 2095 – Textbook orders for visually and hearing impaired students; SDE shall place prior to beginning of fiscal year.
- 11:00 a.m. HB 717 – Newborn infants; require screening for conditions specified by the State Board of Health.
- 1:30 p.m. SB 2501 – Motor vehicles; provide for various distinctive motor vehicle license tags.
- 1:45 p.m. HB 1480 – Abortions; prohibit use of public funds for.
- 2:00 p.m. SB 2983 - Corrections; revise allocation of funds in the Inmate Welfare Fund.
- 2:15 p.m. SB 2249 - Physical education classes K-9; express legislative intent.
