Subject: Deadline to Register for Federal Disaster Assistance is Jan. 13

(Jackson) - Residents and business owners who were affected by the November severe storms have until **Monday, January 13** to register for federal disaster assistance. The counties affected by the storms were Lowndes, Oktibbeha, Clay, Monroe, and Noxubee.

“Anyone who has been affected by the November tornadoes is eligible to register for assistance, even if you have insurance,” said Robert Latham, Director of MEMA. “This is the last chance to apply for federal and state assistance.”
