The Mississippi Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) is closely monitoring the projected path of Tropical Storm Isidore. The following information is being provided to citizens to aid in their safe response to Tropical Storm Isidore.

ROAD INFORMATION

- Hwy 11 in Picayune - water alert on road has been canceled
- Hwy 43 in Pearl River Co at Picayune - unexpected stops & delays
- MS 57 2 miles N of I-10 to S of Quave Rd - Impassable
- Hwy 604 unexpected stops & delays
- MS 609 at Hwy 90 at Ocean Springs - westbound right lane closed for 1/4 mile east Washington Ave and continuing west for 300 ft
- MS 613 south of Highrise Bridge at Moss Point - unexpected stops & delays
- US 49 southbound 2 miles south of McHenry - unexpected stops & delays
- Ingalls Access Ramp on N side of US 90 at Pascagoula
- US 90 - unexpected stops & delays – mostly closed – do not travel unless it is an emergency

POWER OUTAGES

Power outages – some of the coastal counties power supplies are being disconnected for safety reasons while the flood waters are present

- 9000 without power in Metro Jackson area
- 1000 without power in Coastal counties
- 2-3 hours to restore – Statewide
