Governor Echoes Call of President Bush for National Day of Prayer and Remembrance

Jackson, MS – Governor Ronnie Musgrove today added his support to President George Bush's formal proclamation of a National Day of Prayer and Remembrance on Friday, September 14, 2001.

"As a people and a nation, we are united in our grief over Tuesday's events," Musgrove said. "I encourage every Mississippian to take time Friday for reflection and prayer for those killed and injured in the terrorist attacks."

The White House issued a proclamation Thursday afternoon calling on all Americans to mark the day with "noontime memorial services, the ringing of bells at that hour, and evening candlelight remembrance vigils."
