Governor Musgrove Outlines Health Care Proposal During Greenwood Visit

Greenwood, MS – Governor Ronnie Musgrove outlined his health care proposal today at a meeting of the Delta Hills Public Health District at the Greenwood / Leflore County Civic Center.

“It is important for Mississippians around the state to understand exactly what I’ve proposed to address their health care needs,” Musgrove said. “We have some serious issues before us, and I believe this proposal offers a means for us to overcome those issues affecting our people.”

Musgrove first unveiled his proposal at the Neshoba County Fair this past July. The proposal calls for using a portion of the annual tobacco settlement payments to maximize federal health care dollars through Medicaid.

Components of the proposal were endorsed by the State Board of Health in October. Musgrove has been presenting the details of the proposal to audiences of health care professionals and senior citizens in recent weeks.
